## **Snows Volvo, Southampton**







The re-development of the former Cromwell tools site, Southampton, including the demolition of its buildings and site clearance to accommodate the construction of a new Volvo Motor Retail facility comprising of a seven car showroom wrapped around a customer reception, customer 'living room' and cafe, service reception with direct views in to a six bay workshop (all with recessed lift) including MOT testing bay, parts storage complete with mezzanine over together with ancillary spaces, staff & technician restrooms. External works including 28 select car display spaces, customer parking with EV charging, brand and dealership signage.





## Key challenges/features

- / Project hiatus and re-start due to Covid 19, required negotiation of mutually agreeable terms between Client and Trade Contractors, which was successfully achieved.
- / Enhanced H&S procedures due to Covid 19.
- / Working near an adjacent building sensitive to vibration, vibration monitoring employed during ground works phase.
- / Working adjacent to multiple live car sales/service sites.
- / Value engineering a foundation solution, moving away from piled foundations to traditional concrete pads on stabilised ground.
- / Ensuring compliance with VOLVO brand standards.
- / Liaison with and coordination of Client preferred supply chain for specialist equipment, fit out and FF&E.
- / Ensuring a high standard of finish commensurate with the VOLVO brand whilst maintaining programme and budget.
