Rekan were appointed to provide a multi-disciplinary service to design, procure, manage, coordinate and administer the refurbishment and over roofing of the 9 no. Nodal roofs of the oceanography centre, 7 no. out-buildings and ancillary workshop and stores with a combined area of circa 4,000m².



Key challenges/features

- / Working in close proximity to the Solent within the demise of Associated British Ports and Associated HMRC Customs and Exile secure compounds.
- / Working within a live scientific research establishment co-ordinating logistic moves to ensure minimal disruption to operations serving quayside moves, arrivals and departures.
- / Administering the project during NOC moving to an independent, self-governing organisation and charitable company.
- / Engaging and liaising with all project stakeholders including researchers, Estates and Facilities, quayside operators and Associated British Ports.
- / Working alongside an operating freight train line.
