Re-development of brownfield site within the small market town of Bishops Waltham to create three speculative industrial units for leasing to small businesses by Winchester City Council. External works included the creation of retaining walls to create dedicated car parking and landscaped areas.





Key challenges/features

- / Working on a brownfield site with demolition of 1950s warehouses.
- / Complicated site levels, leading to retaining walls and engineered solutions.
- / Adjacent to residential units so care and consideration were paramount.
- / BREEAM (excellent) requirements so the inclusion of 78 roof-mounted photovoltaic panels, three electric vehicle charging points and a low-energy LED lighting system were installed.
